Instruction

Life Cycle Stage Discussion (7 Pages)

- Look at Each Page: Each page covers a different life cycle stage, including the stage name, age limit, a picture, and a poem.
- Read the Information: Read the name and age limit carefully. Look at the picture to see what that stage looks like.
- Enjoy the Poem: Read the poem on each page that describes the stage in a fun way.
- Discuss: Talk with a friend, teacher, or family member about what you learned on each page.

Human Life Cycle Diagrams (2 Pages)

- Examine the Diagrams: Look at the diagrams that show the human life cycle visually.
- Identify Each Stage: Point out each stage and say its name out loud.
- Color the Diagrams: If you want, you can color the diagrams to make them more vibrant and fun!

Human Life Cycle Matching Activity (1 Page)

- Read the Instructions: Follow the instruction that says, "Draw a line to match each stage to the age."
- Match the Stages: Look at the stages on one side and their corresponding ages on the other side.
- Draw Lines: Use a pencil or crayon to draw lines connecting each life cycle stage to its correct age.
